Types of support available

- *Support is not available in the form of overnight babysitting or babysitting of sick children.

After-School Care Centers

Allowances & Subsidies

Child Allowance (*Jidō Teate*)

The child allowance is paid to individuals raising a child/children up to and including 3rd grade of junior high school (i.e. up until March 31st after the child turns 15 years old.) (Income restrictions apply.)

Child Medical Expense Subsidy (Kodomo Iryōhi Josei)

Partial subsidy for medical expenses for children up to age 15 (until March 31st after turning 15.)

* From September 2020, hospitalization for children up to 18 is also eligible.

Orphan Allowance (*Iji Teate*)

The orphan allowance is paid to individuals raising children aged 18 or younger (including those with severe disabilities but not including those who have been institutionalized) missing one or both parents. (Income restrictions apply.)

Child Support Allowance (*Jidō Fuyō Teat*e)

The child support allowance is paid to individuals raising children aged 18 or younger (including those with severe disabilities) missing one or both parents, or children under 20 years old suffering from moderate or severe physical and/or mental disabilities missing one or both parents (in both cases, does not include children living in a public institution.) (Income restrictions apply.)

Medical Expense Subsidy for Single-Parent Family (*Boshikateitō Iryōhi Josei*)

Medical Subsidies Office \$\(\cup\$23-6148 FAX 27-1160\)

The following individuals may have a portion of their medical expenses from insurance provided treatment subsidized: single parents (including one with a spouse suffering from disabilities of a specified severity) raising a child aged 18 or younger, children of a single parent; and children without parents (not including children living in an institution.) (Income restrictions apply.)

School Education

Admission notice

Every September, each elementary school sends a notice for health checkup at school, and in January, the Board of Education mails an admission notice (a separate notice will be sent to those who move to or move within the city after the notice period has passed.)

<u>Changing schools (According to the notification of residence transfer, a new school is designated.)</u>

[Moving to Okazaki from another city]

Upon notification of change of address, an admission designation notice (入学指定通知書) will be issued, so please obtain a student registration certificate (在学証明書) issued by the previous school and submit the notice to the designated school.

[Moving within Okazaki]

Upon notification of change of address, an admission designation notice (入学指定通知書) will be issued, so please obtain a student registration certificate (在学証明書) from the previous school and submit it to the (new) indicated school.

[Moving out of Okazaki]

After receiving a student registration certificate (在学証明書), file a City Move-out Notification and complete the necessary formalities.

Scholarship Loan System

Scholarship Fund (Application scheduled to be available from September to November)

This is a system to lend necessary financial support (up to 400,000 yen per year) to university students and vocational school students enrolled in a specialist training course and in trouble for economic reasons.

Grant System for Private High School Tuition

Grant for school tuition (Application is scheduled to be available in October.)

This is a system to provide school tuition grants (up to 12,000 yen per year) for parents of students attending private high schools, etc. (Income restrictions apply.)

Financial Support System on School Enrollment

This is a system to support financially troubled parents of elementary and junior high school students by offering financial assistance with regard to fees for school supplies, school food, school excursions, and other expenses (Income restrictions apply.)

Incentive System for Enrolling in Special Needs Education

This is a system to support households with a child enrolling in a special class in elementary or junior high school, or for whom special assistance equivalent to that of a school special class is required. In order to alleviate the financial burden, school supply fees, school lunch fees, and other expenses are subsidized. (Income restrictions apply.)
