## **Trash Disposal Rules**

## 3 Basic rules for putting out the trash!!!

- **♦Properly separate trash and recyclables!**
- ◆Have the trash out, in the proper bag(s), by 8:30 on the correct collection days!
- **♦Put out each type of trash at the correct collection station!**

## **Burnable Items**

kitchen refuse • wastepaper • plastic items that cannot be cleaned • rubber or leather products • dirty paper or plastic containers • ice packs • desiccant • hand warmers • diapers (\*please flush any excrement down the toilet) • records, CDs, DVDs and their cases • weeds, branches and leaves, (please be sure to put them in the designated bag) • cassette tapes, video tapes, and their cases • dirtied cloth

**How to dispose:** Drain any kitchen refuse, put it in the designated bag, and take it to the **burnable trash station**.

Please drain liquids from burnable trash

### Non-Burnable Items

Broken glass • metal • razors • knives • pottery • aluminum foil • aluminum products • umbrellas • 18-liter cans • pots • kettles • broken bottles • mirrors • small electric appliances • game devices (used small-scale home appliances are collected at recycle stations. We ask for your cooperation in the separation and collection of recyclable resources.

**How to dispose:** Put the trash in the designated bag, and take it to the **non-burnable trash** station.

- Wrap sharp objects in paper and display them in a way that they can recognized.
- Please use up all the contents of containers to de disposed.

## Paper Containers/Packaging



#### Any items with this mark that are not dirty.

**Cups • paper cylinders:** paper cups, snack containers

Cardboard • Paper trays: paper pudding tray, toothbrush package back cardboard

Empty boxes: snack boxes, tissue boxes

Paper bags • shopping bags: chopstick sleeves, retail paper bags, etc.

**How to dispose:** Empty the items, fold or break them down, put them inside the designated bag for paper containers and wrapping and take them to the **recycling station**.

## PET Bottles



#### Any items with this mark that are not dirty.

PET bottles for beverages, soy sauce, alcohol (sake, shochu, mirin) and condiments that do not contain oil.

- \*Remove the cap and label and dispose of them as plastic waste.
- \*Coloured plastic bottles are also collected.

**How to dispose:** Remove all lids and labels, empty the contents, lightly rinse, crush, place in a bag designated for PET bottles and take to the **recycling station.**XYou can also put it in the collection box of a cooperating store.

## Plastic Containers/Packaging



Any items with this mark that are not dirty.

Bottles: sauce or cooking oil bottles, shampoo/detergent containers, etc.

**Boxes/cases:** trays for fresh food/sashimi, packs for tooth brushes, etc., cases for medicine/cosmetics/daily necessities, etc.

Cups: cup noodle, pudding and yogurt containers, packaging for eggs or tofu

Bags/Wrapping: bags for snacks, bread, frozen foods, clothing products, plastic wrap

**How to dispose:** Empty out the items, lightly rinse and crush or break down any items that you can, fold things like trays to reduce excess bulk, put the items in a bag designated for plastics and take it to the **recycling station.** 

## **Empty Cans**

Cans for beverages, food, etc., can lids, metal caps

**How to dispose**: Take cans to the neighborhood recycling station and put them in the **blue** container.

- Empty the contents and rinse lightly before taking out.
- ※ Do not crush the cans.

## **Empty Bottles**

Beverage, condiment and cosmetic bottles.

**How to dispose:** Take bottles to the neighborhood recycling station and put them in the **brown** container.

- Metal caps go with "Empty cans." Plastic caps go with "Plastic Containers/
   Packaging."
- Empty the contents and rinse lightly before taking out.
- ※ Please dispose of broken items as non-burnable trash.

### Refillable Bottles

Beer bottles, 1.8-liter "issho-bin" bottles.



- **How to dispose:** Take bottles to the neighborhood recycling station and put them in the **white container**.
  - Empty the contents and rinse lightly before taking out.
  - ※ Please dispose of broken items as non-burnable trash.



#### Flammable Hazardous Waste

Lighters, igniting tools, gas cartridges, spray cans **\*No puncturing**.

How to dispose: Make sure to use up the contents completely and put the waste in the yellow container at the neighborhood recycling station.

※ If not completely used up, please indicate by writing "残りあり/nokori ari."

## Oversized Trash

**[For Carry-in]** \*The amount and types of carry-in trash are restricted.

Charges: 70 Yen per 10 kilos.

## [Request for Door-to-Door Pay Collection]

- Step 1: Make an appointment with the Oversized Trash Reception Center ( 22-2000)

  Appointments can be made one month before your preferred date for trash collection.

  Please call for an appointment between 8:30am and 5:15pm, Monday through Friday (excluding national holidays, and year-end holidays). May request up to 5 items or up to 8 stickers (2,400 yen worth) each time.
- Step 2: Purchase stickers for oversized waste at a designated store.

  Stickers sell for 300 yen each. Depending on the dimensions and weights of the items, the number of necessary stickers differs. Stickers are not refundable. Please purchase stickers after making a collection appointment.
- Step 3: Fill in your reception number or your name on the sticker. Put the necessary number of stickers on the oversized trash items. Place the trash outside your house (ground floor) by 8:30 am on the day of the appointment.

## **Hazardous Waste**

Mercury thermometers, mercury blood pressure monitors

**How to dispose**: Put it in the **yellow container** at the neighborhood recycling station. Put the waste in a transparent plastic bag.

Fluorescent lights/dry cell batteries

**How to dispose**: Put it in the white collection container at cooperating stores or the collection locations at city hall and the civic center.

#### Trash Collection Calendar

Every March, we distribute to every household a "trash collection calendar" showing the collection dates for the upcoming fiscal year.

If you do not have one, you can get one from the Public Sanitation Division (3<sup>rd</sup> floor, Recycle Plaza Office Building), the Environmental Preservation Division (5<sup>th</sup> floor, Welfare Hall (Fukushi Kaikan)), City Information Corner (1<sup>st</sup> floor, City Hall West Building), each branch office, and the city hall homepage.

## **City-Designated Trash/Recyling Bags**

There are five bag designations: burnable trash, non-burnable trash, paper containers & packaging, PET bottles, and plastic containers & packaging. They are available in large (equivalent to 45 liters) and small (equivalent to 30 liters) sizes, as well as even smaller bags (equivalent to 10 liters) limited to burnable trash. These designated bags can be purchased at supermarkets and convenience stores. Please be sure to use them when you dispose of trash at the trash collection stations.

## **Large Amounts of Trash**

When you want to throw out a large amount of trash all together because you are moving, cleaning house, or other reasons, please bring it to the Clean Center or ask a licensed collection and transportation company to dispose of it. Please do not inconvenience your neighbors by taking it all to the neighborhood trash collection station.

## **Collection at cooperating stores**

## Recycling of the 4 large types of home appliance

If you wish to dispose of one of the four types of household appliances (television, refrigerator/freezer, washing machine/clothes dryer, or air conditioner) a recycling fee is required.

## When you buy a replacement or know where the original product was purchased

Please pay the recycling fee and collection & transportation fee to the store where you purchased or will purchase the appliance and request collection.

#### When you don't know the store where it was purchased

- **Step 1:** After confirming the size and manufacturer of the home appliances you want to dispose of, pay the recycling fee at the post office.
- **Step 2:** Please bring it directly to a designated pick-up location or ask the oversized garbage reception center to collect it (\$\frac{1}{2}\) 22-2000).

### **Collection by Delivery Company**

- Apply with the cooperating business, ReNet Japan Recycling Co., Ltd. (<a href="https://www.renet.jp/">https://www.renet.jp/</a>)
- Collection of up to one box (including main body of the computer) per retrieval is free.
- Please remove all data from the computer before collection. Alternatively, data removal service is also available for a fee.

## **Collection by Manufacturer**

Step 1: Please inquire with the manufacturer's reception center.

In the case of a home built PC or unknown manufacturer, please ask the PC3R

Promotion Association (<a href="https://www.pc3r.jp/">https://www.pc3r.jp/</a>) to collect it (<a href="https://www.pc3r.jp/">https://www.pc3r.jp/</a>)

Step 2: (In the case where there is no recycle mark on the computer)

Use the recycle fee transfer slip from the manufacturer to pay the fee at a post office.

**Step 3:** The manufacturer will send a Yu Pack. Pack the computer inside and send it through the post office.

We will issue a subsidy to those who live in the city and purchase an electric kitchen waste disposer or compost bin to try to reduce the amount of kitchen waste.

## [How to apply]

Within 60 days of purchase (within the same fiscal year), bring your receipt, proof of payment, and your account information to the Public Sanitation Division (3<sup>rd</sup> floor, Recycling Plaza), the Environmental Preservation Division (5<sup>th</sup> floor, Welfare Hall (Fukushi Kaikan)), or the branch offices. Payments are on a first-come-first-served basis, within yearly budget.

You may bring in household landfill waste (trash other than landfill waste is not accepted). Xlandfill waste: broken glass, Ceramics, concrete, blocks, bricks, and earth/sand

## **General Business-related Trash**

Please outsource to a licensed collection and transportation company authorized by the city, or dispose of it directly at a clean center.
