National Health Insurance

The national health insurance is a public medical insurance plan run by municipal governments. The following persons with residence registration in Okazaki must enroll in the Okazaki City national health insurance plan: persons who are not covered by work-related health insurance or mutual aid health insurance plans, and who are not on social welfare or receive other benefits.

Formalities may be completed at the National Pension & Health Insurance Division (1st floor, East Building) and branch offices (shisho).

In all cases, please be prepared to show your My Number Card or other document showing your Individual Number and ID.

● When moving to Okazaki

Certificate of change of address (^{tenshutsu shōmeisho}転出証明書).

● After withdrawing from a workplace health insurance plan

Document indicating the date of withdrawal.

● When an insured person dies

Eligibility confirmation certificate, passbook of a bank account in the name of the funeral executor, document certifying that a funeral was held

● When the householder and/or insured person's name is/are changed

National Pension

National pension is a compulsory public pension system requiring anyone (with the exception of civil servants, employee pension insurance recipients, and spouses dependent on such pension members) with an address in Japan aged 20 to 59 to register.



Procedures and items to bring

Please bring either the applicant's My Number Card or a document listing the applicant's My Number and the photo ID of the person coming to the counter.

- **After leaving one's job**

Pension book, basic pension number notification, and documents showing the date one stopped working

- **When someone who enrolled voluntarily while working overseas moves to the city**

Pension book or basic pension number notification.

- **When someone who is not enrolled in the National Pension program moves to Okazaki from another city.**

- ◆ **After losing dependent status under employees' or mutual-benefit pension insurance plan**

- **After a spouse left his/her place of employment**

Pension book, basic pension number notification, and documents showing the date of leaving the company

- **After losing dependent status under one's spouse's employees' pension insurance plan**

Pension handbook, basic pension number notification, document indicating the date of losing the dependent status.

Medical Care System for the Elderly

This is a medical insurance system for persons aged 75 or older, or persons aged 65 or older with certain disabilities. Members of the national health insurance plan or other medical insurance plans will be insured under the medical care system for the

elderly (後期高齢者医療制度^{kōki kōreisha iryō seido}) from their 75th birthday. This system is run cooperatively by the Aichi Prefecture-Association of Medical Care for the Elderly and the City of Okazaki.

- **When moving to Aichi**

Certificate of Classification and Division of Payment (負担区分等証明書 futankubuntō shōmeisho)

- **When moving out of Aichi**

Eligibility confirmation certificate (資格確認書 shikaku kakuninsho)

- **When the insured person's name has changed**

Photo ID (residence card, driver's license, etc.)

- **When your eligibility confirmation certificate (資格確認書 shikaku kakuninsho) or eligibility information notice (資格情報 shikaku jōhō) is unusable due to damage**

Photo ID (residence card, driver's license, etc.), the unusable eligibility confirmation certificate

- **When an insured person dies**

Eligibility confirmation certificate, passbook of a bank account in the name of the funeral executor, document certifying that a funeral was held (funeral letter, funeral receipt, etc.)
